<u>David Geller</u> is a 14th generation jeweler, starting his training in his father's manufacturing facility at the age of 10. Later David worked as a jeweler for Neiman Marcus in Atlanta as their Jeweler and Starting Jewelry Artisans in 1974. When he sold his store to an employee in January of 2000, the year before the store did well over \$1.8 million in sales with 75% of that coming from the shop, and doing almost 9,000 job envelopes a year!

Over the years David developed his now famous pricing guide: **Geller's Pricing Guide to Repairs and Custom Design.** Used by over 6,000 jewelers in America, the U.K., Italy, Guam and Canada, this guide provides profitable pricing, as developed in David's store.

Now, David's life mission is to help jewelers make and keep more money from their store and being an expert in their own business in: Repair and custom designing selling; understanding how much inventory to have and at what price points using their point of sale program; commission and compensation programs and store organization.

David has spoken to jewelers across the country including: IJO; RJO; AGS; over 75% of all state Jewelers of America state associations; JCK program in Vegas and in over 400 in-store consultations.
